His introduction to the actress Paulette Goddard would imbue him with fresh creativity and allow him to turn the corner his work needed. Abandoning comedy for a more politically motivated tone, Chaplin set about making what remain his most memorable movies: *Modern Times* and The Dictator.

Shortly after graduating from art school, Mathieu Bablet sent his first comic book project, The Beautiful Death, to Ankama which was noticed immediately by Run and published as part of the Label 619 collection. Then follows several successful books, such as Shangri-La and the acclaimed Carbon & Silicon.

8 chapters drawn by talented and eclectic artists: Allanva, Thomas Rouzière, Rours, Sumi, Daphné Collignon, Titouan Beaulin, Claire Fauvel, and Quentin Rigaud. Additional scriptwork by Isabelle Bauthian. Mathieu Bablet masterminds an epic saga, entrusting the artwork to eight artists while his own links the chapters which he scripted.

Sheridan and Johnson, two members of the Midnight Order, are on a global mission to track down witches who have become too powerful and pose a threat to the world and indeed themselves. 






A SHORT STORY: THE TRUE TALE OF THE BLACK DAHLIA

Florent Maudoux earned a university degree in mathematics, a diploma in piano, and also graduated in film animation. His collaboration with Run and Label 619 began in 2008 with a title that was an immediate success with a teenage and young adult audience: Freaks' Squeele in 7 volumes.

Run had a varied creative career with several major brands before debuting in comics and publishing the first volume of MFKZ with Ankama. He directed Label 619 for 13 years, and also worked as editorial director of Ankama. He launched and has contributed to the series DoggyBags since 2010. He cowrote and co-directed the animated movie adaptation of MFKZ.

Probably the most well-researched account of the Black Dahlia to date, putting the focus on her life rather than her grisly murder.

In meticulous detail, A Short Story tells the true story of Elizabeth Short, better known as "the Black Dahlia", who also inspired the eponymous James Ellroy novel, who moved to Los Angeles from her native Massachusetts in the hope of becoming a Hollywood star. The story and dialogue trace the life of this young woman lost in Hollywood, in particular the three months leading up to her horrific murder, and is based on eyewitness accounts from those who knew and associated with her.

From her stay at the Figueroa Hotel with Marjorie Grahams to the incident in San Diego, A Short Story is a methodically documented account, a far cry from the usual clichés about a female figure we thought we already knew everything about.

A meticulously researched script based upon declassified FBI files.











Neyef grew up in Germany. After art school studies in France, he began his comic book career and soon crossed paths with Run and Label 619. He worked on short stories for DoggyBags and Midnight Tales, and drew Puta Madre, a spin-off series in the Mutafukaz universe. Hoka Hey is his latest full length project with Label 619.

A coming-of-age story that is both brutal yet full of emotion and humanity.

HISTORICAL CONTEXT

From 1850, Native American children were forcibly detained in Catholic boarding schools to assimilate them into the American nation. By 1900, the native population had fallen by 93% due to new diseases brought over by the colonizers, state-subsidized exterminations, and deportations.

George is a young boy from the Lakota tribe who has been raised by the pastor of his reserve. Acculturated, he gradually forgets his roots and begins to dream of a future inspired by the rapidly developing American way of life. He eventually crosses paths with Little Knife, a cold and violent Native American searching for his mother's murderer. Along with his two companions, he tears George away from his life to bring him along on his quest. Over the course of their journey, man and boy will open up to one another and discover what truly matters to them: for Little Knife, passing on his culture to soothe the rage eating away at him; for George, discovering his identity and origins.







Since 1996, Mathieu Sapin, has drawn comic books for both children (Akissi with Marguerite Abouet and Sardine de l'espace with Joann Sfar and Emmanuel Guibert) as well as adults. He is known for his observational comics such as Campagne Présidentielle, Le Château, and most recently Carnet de campagne 2022.

Tomi Ungerer (1931-2019) was a poster artist, authorillustrator, inventor, collector and commercial artist. He is considered one of the most important author's in children's literature for over 60 years, with works such as *Moon Man* and *The Three Robbers*. In 1998 he received the Hans-Christian Andersen Award, often referred to as the Nobel Prize for children's literature, for his lasting contribution to the field.





After graduating in comic books from the Institut Saint-Luc in Brussels, Léonie Bischoff worked in a bookstore while writing for publishing house Manolosanctis. 2010 saw the publication of *Princesse Suplex* before publishing *Hoodoo Darlin'* with Casterman, as well as three adaptations of works by the Swedish writing Camilla Läckberg together with Oliver Bocquet. In 2021, she won a Fauve award at Angoulême.

Kathleen Karr grew up on a farm in New Jersey, USA. After studying English literature, she began working in the movie industry. Her writing career began in the 90's when she wrote *It Ain't Always Easy* and discovered that she really enjoyed writing for children. Her novels have won numerous awards in the United States and abroad.
